(three) Scope of recruitment and basic conditions for candidates

- 1. Open to the world, regardless of nationality, geography, gender.
- 2. Age limit: under 40 years old.

3. Candidates for performers must have a bachelor's degree or higher, or a performance level equivalent to a bachelor's degree or higher, and have excellent professional qualities and skills.

4. Have some ability to communicate in English and be comfortable with daily rehearsals and professional communication in English.

5. Physically and mentally healthy, with no criminal record.

(6. Full-time employment upon admission, no part-time applicants will be accepted.)

7. Admission is made on the basis of merit through preliminary examinations and retests.

(four) Performer examination content

The recruitment is selected in an online format. It includes two sessions.

First session - submit application materials and upload preliminary test video, online pre-selection.

Second session - online video call for assessment.

2. A video of the applicant playing a piece of their choice, 10 minutes or less in length.

(You may play with piano accompaniment; please ensure that the examiner can clearly see the applicant's face, hands and instrument.)

3. Degree Certificate.

Please fill in the subject of your email as "Recruitment/Candidate's name/Position ".

The orchestra's recruitment office will notify pre-selected candidates within 14 working days of receiving their application. Applicants who are not successful in the preliminary audition will not be notified.

Review examination online video call assessment requirements.

1. the re-examination will be conducted in the form of an online video call.

2. Candidates can decide for themselves whether they need a steel accompanist for their solo repertoire, please make sure that the examiners can clearly see your face, hands and instrument.

3. Band repertoire selections will be drawn by lot for two songs.

(Five) Salary and Conditions

1. Sign a labor contract, the contract period is 1 year, the probationary period is 30 days; the contract period is 2 years, the probationary period is 60 days

2. Salary composition: guaranteed salary + floating performance (negotiation)

3. Insurance and tax payment

4. In addition to the national holidays, 20-30 days paid vacation

5. Provide free apartment
