The Gustav Mahler Academy offers an artistic experience that is unique in its excellence and diversity. Perfect your instrumental skills and gain invaluable experience by playing in ensembles of all genres. Develop an international network of peers and leading personalities in the international music scene. Spend unforgettable summer weeks in **Bolzano** and in the picturesque mountain village of **Toblach**, where Mahler once composed.

To offer a deeper and more sustainable learning experience, starting this year the Gustav Mahler Academy is organized as a biennial program. In case of a successful audition, you will be admitted to both summer academies 2023 and 2024. Your participation in both academies will be mandatory.

The academies include:

- ---- Chamber orchestra with musicians from the Mahler Chamber Orchestra
- --- World premiere of a work by G.F. Haas with musicians from Klangforum Wien

- --- Experience with gut strings and original Viennese instruments from 1900
- --- Full-size symphony orchestra side by side with 50 members of top European Orchestras on period instruments
- --- Concerts and touring
- --- Full scholarship for all admitted students



Gustav Mahler Academy I July 25 – August 11, 2023

Paris 1890–1920: Debussy – Ravel – Stravinsky

You will receive **individual lessons** with a free choice of repertoire by musical personalities such as **Gregory Ahss**, **Kerson Leong**, **Veronika Hagen**, **Alban Gerhardt**, **Olivier Patey** and **Rick Stotijn**.

Guided by specialists from **Klangforum Wien**, you will be part of the **world premiere** of *11.000 Saiten* for 50 pianos and ensemble by **Georg Friedrich Haas**, thus gaining experience in the performance of contemporary music at the highest level. *11.000 Saiten* has been commissioned by the Ferruccio Busoni – Gustav Mahler Foundation with the support of the Ernst von Siemens Music Foundation.

Together with musicians from the **Mahler Chamber Orchestra** you will perform chamber music as well as in an MCO-size chamber orchestra under the direction of composer/conductor **Matthias Pintscher**. On the programs will be music by Debussy, Ravel, Stravinsky, Poulenc, Roussel and others.

Each year several key musicians from the **Mahler Chamber Orchestra** teach at the Gustav Mahler Academy as Resident Tutors. They play in chamber music groups with the students and perform side by side with them in an MCO-size chamber orchestra, conducted by one of the MCO's regular conductors. They share their knowledge with their younger colleagues, their dedication, their sense of quality and perfection as well as their ability to listen to each other.

Gustav Mahler Academy 2023/2024

Gustav Mahler Academy II August 25 – September 15, 2024 (dates t.b.c.)

Originalklang-Project Vienna 1890–1920 on original instruments: Brahms – Mahler – Schönberg

On the instruments of the Vienna Philharmonic from 1900, which are made available to you by the *Euregio Kulturzentrum Toblach* Foundation, you will acquire profound knowledge in performance practice of late romantic music. **No prior experience of original instruments is required.**

Guided by luminaries like **Clive Brown**, you will discover chamber music from Brahms to Mahler and Schönberg on **original instruments** and perform in beautiful locations in South Tyrol. Side by side with **50 musicians from top European ensembles**, you will work with star pianist **Leif Ove Andsnes** and conductor **Philipp von Steinaecker** on Rachmaninoff's 3rd piano concerto and Mahler's 5th symphony in a full-size symphony orchestra on original instruments.

After concerts in **Toblach** and **Bolzano** the orchestra will tour to **Paris**, **Cologne** and other European cities to perform this music for the first time since 1910 on the instruments it was written for. The Originalklang-Project is a production of the **Ferruccio Busoni – Gustav Mahler Foundation** in close cooperation with the **Euregio-Cultural Center Gustav Mahler Toblach-Dolomites Foundation**.
